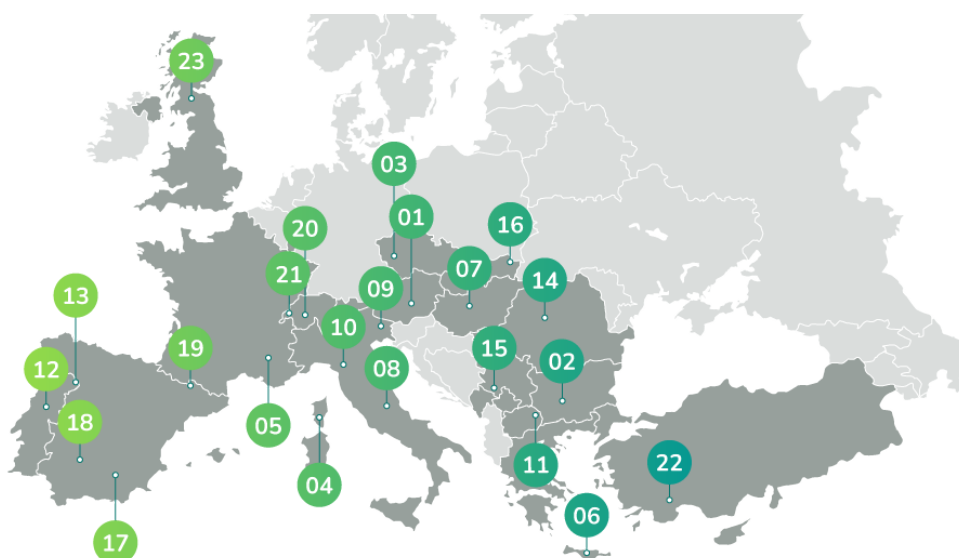
## MOVING's contribution to the EU Long-term vision for rural areas
